AMERICAN AVALANCHE ASSOCIATION MEMORIAL LIST.

In the fall of 2007 the board of directors of the American Avalanche Association's approved the formation of a Memorial List, to honor and remember those individuals that were killed while engaged in avalanche & snow safety related work.

The criterion for being listed on the American Avalanche Association Memorial list is:

The American victim must have been engaged in either a professional or in a volunteer capacity while "on the clock," in snow-safety and or avalanche rescue work, at the time that they were killed.

As of August 2010, there are Fifty-one individuals listed on the American Avalanche Association's Memorial list. These individuals make-up a complete cross section of "snow & avalanche workers."
