BACKCOUNTRY SKIER ATTITUDES AND THE UTAU AVALANCHE FORECAST CENTER

Surveys of backcountry users in the LAFC forecast area show changes in attitudes towards avalanche danger and personnel user responsibility. Surveys conducted since 1976 show user increases of 25% per year. During this period avalanche phone infonnation calls have increased 6 times to a present call rate of 34,000 per year in the Salt Lake area. Awareness of the avalanche information number has changed from 70% who were unaware of the number in 1976 to 77% aware in 1982. While the awareness of the information number has increased, only 58% called the information number. Perception of the avalanche hazard by the public, trained mountain observers, and the UAFC is examined.
