MEMORANDUM

Subject: Proceed time.

References: (a) Art. 132 Navy Regulations.
(b) Chapter 4, Part C, BuPers Manual.

1. The following explanation of proceed time is made to assist officers in the proper interpretation of orders, thus avoiding tardiness in reporting for duty with resultant checkage of pay accounts:

A. DEFINITION OF PROCEED TIME

- (1) "PROCEED" - Report within FOUR DAYS exclusive of travel time following receipt of orders.
- (2) "PROCEED WITHOUT DELAY" - Report within FORTY-EIGHT HOURS exclusive of travel time following receipt of orders.
- (3) "PROCEED IMMEDIATELY" - Report within TWELVE HOURS exclusive of travel time following receipt of orders.

B. COMPUTATION OF PROCEED TIME

- (1) "Proceed" orders
Where detachment is involved, proceed time begins the first day following detachment. On orders from inactive to active duty, proceed time begins the day following receipt of orders. For example, if an officer is detached or receives his orders to active duty on 1 August he must begin the travel (or report, where no travel is involved) by 2400 on 5 August.
- (2) "Proceed without delay" and "Proceed immediately" orders
Proceed time on "proceed without delay" and "Proceed immediately" orders is computed from the hour such orders are received. For example, if an officer is detached from duty or receives his orders to active duty at 1200 on 1 August he must begin the travel (or report, where no travel is involved) by 1200 on 3 August under "proceed without delay" orders, and by 2400 on 1 August under "proceed immediately" orders.
- (3) Points to be borne in mind
 - (a) Where travel is involved, travel time (figured over the shortest usually traveled route) should be added to allowed proceed time in determining when an officer is due to report.

(3) Points to be borne in mind. (Cont'd)

(b) UNDER ORDERS WHICH CARRY AN OFFICER THROUGH SEVERAL DUTY STATIONS, THE OFFICER IS ENTITLED TO AND MAY BE PAID FOR PROCEED TIME TAKEN BEFORE REPORTING TO THE FIRST STATION MENTIONED IN THE ORDERS ONLY; i.e., only one "proceed time" is allowed under any given set of orders.

(c) On change of station, an officer is entitled to and may be paid for allowed proceed time under each separate set of orders regardless of the type of duty (temporary duty, temporary duty under instruction, permanent duty) from which the officer is being detached or to which he is being assigned.

(d) On orders not involving detachment (other than orders to active duty) the computation of proceed time is dependent upon the terms of the orders; i.e., whether they require the officer to proceed on a certain date, report on a certain date, etc., and is governed by the circumstances in each particular case.

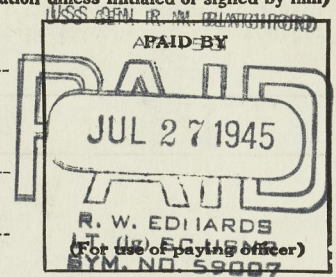

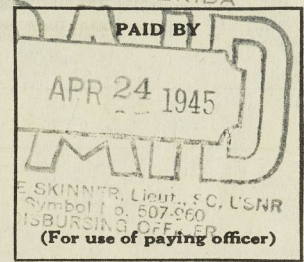
