

THE BED & BREAKFAST WOMAN ANGLER



In 1974, Annette developed and taught the first fly fishing seminar for women offered in the U.S. Annette was also the first licensed woman fishing guide in Montana. She has been featured in news and magazine articles and appeared with her family in a nationally broadcast fly fishing program. For Annette, fly fishing is more than just a recreational sport, it's a lifestyle. Annette currently lives in Chico, where in addition to teaching fly fishing, she owns and operates her own management accounting firm.




