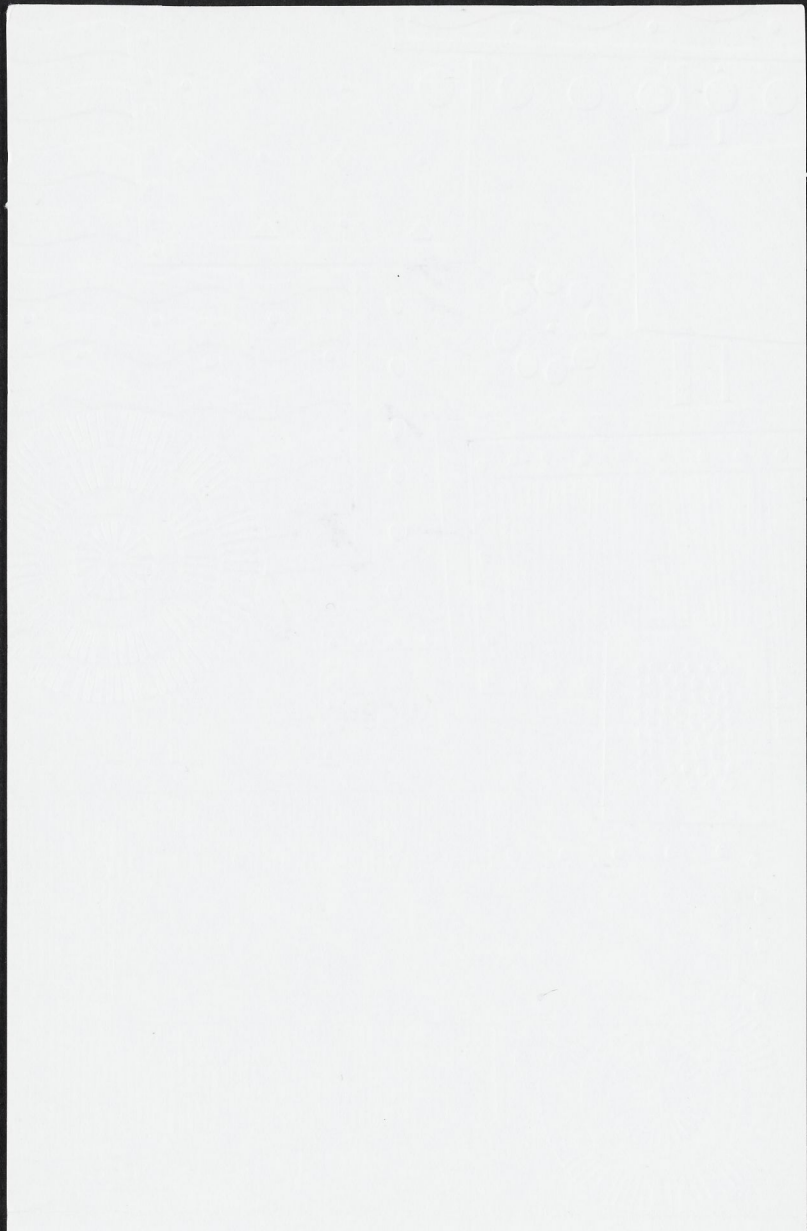

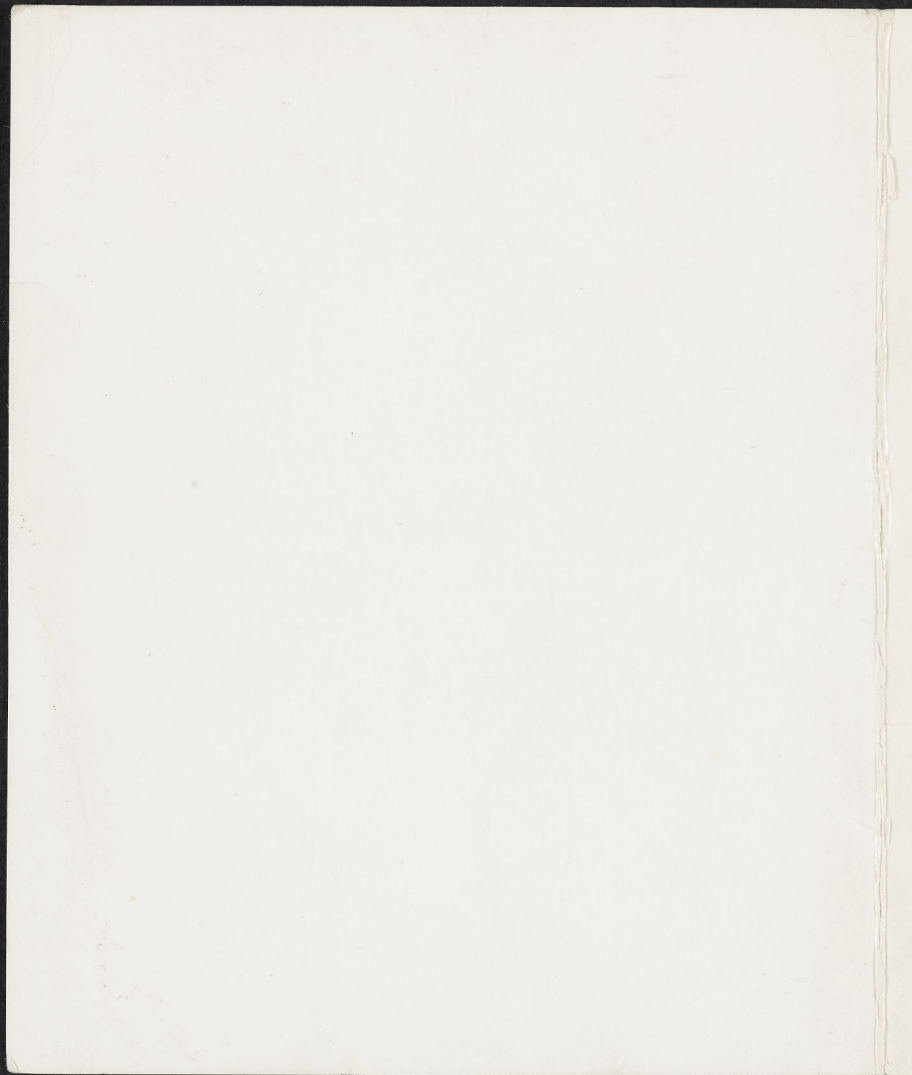

And trout that the amber pools hold.

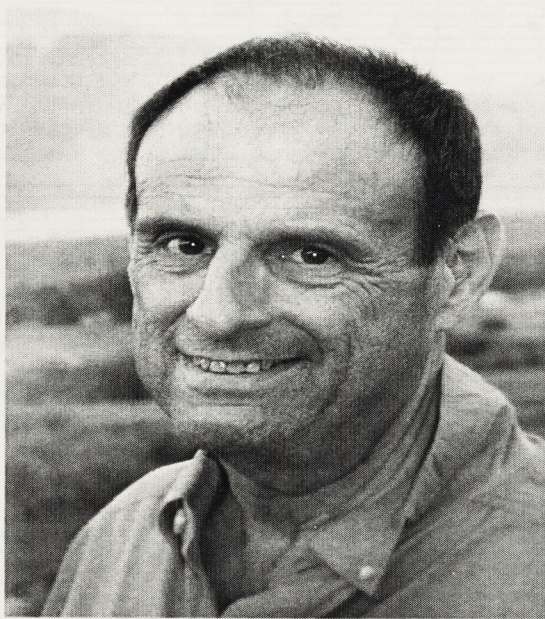
And so the whole evening I sit in my chair,
