ATLANTIC SALMON (spawning colors), *Salmo salar*. Unlike the five species of Pacific salmon, Atlantic salmon can spawn two or even three times, although a very small percentage do. They enter rivers in the fall where they swim many miles upstream to spawn in clean gravel. Males develop a distinctive hooked jaw or kype in fresh water. They reach sexual maturity at various ages, having spent one, two or three winters in the ocean.
