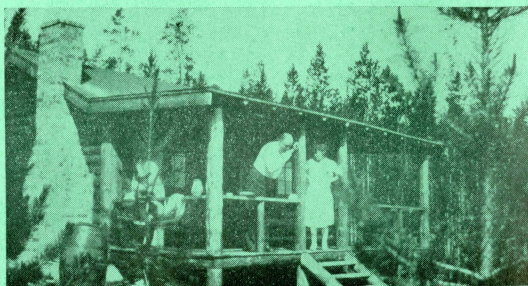


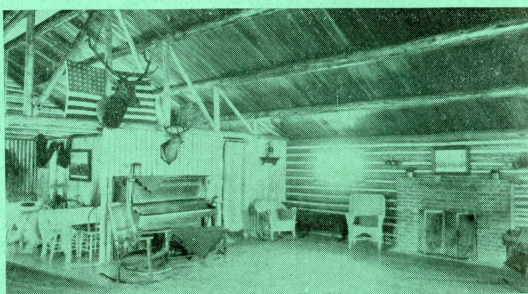

\$65.00 to \$75.00 per week, per person. Special rates as low as \$55.00 for families, large groups, or guests staying an extended period, quoted upon request. Rates include cabins, meals, horses, boats, all entertainment on the ranch, horseback trips that can be made in one day, special attention to those unused to western horses and saddles. Rates do not include long auto trips or overnight pack trips, personal laundry or commissary supplies. Reservations must be made in advance. The lore of the old Western horse and cattle country survives at Haggin Ranch. Yes, traditions and reminders of Indian days, road agents, vigilantes, prospectors, "ghost" cities and cattle rustlers all are yours to explore. Three hundred miles of

trails wind in every direction from the ranch through a labyrinth of mountainous canyons, dashing streams, crystalline lakes, velvety meadows, hot springs, caves, old mines, —all rimmed by the rugged grandeur of 28 of the highest peaks of the Rockies; It's the Old West, the Real West!

Scenic Beauty, Fishing and Thrills

Back in the hills the true sportsman finds a wonderland of rushing mountain streams where he may cast for wily trout. Or a picturesque waterfall or secluded spring will delight the camera enthusiast or nature lover. Many guests find excitement in panning gold from the streams and sandbars near the ranch.



A Haven for Wildlife and Game

Adjoining the ranch in the wilderness area are found moose, elk, bear, mountain goat and sheep, deer, lions, lynx, coyotes, beaver, mink, and much small game. In the lakes and streams are many kinds of water fowl such as ducks, geese, heron, crane. Hunting and fishing, in season, are great at Haggin Ranch.

Haggin Ranch is situated on the south shore of this large lake which affords splendid swimming, boating and fishing. U. S. Highway No. 10A parallels the north shore. Anaconda lies 20 miles to the east and is quickly accessible for medical aid and supplies not available at the ranch. Telephone and daily mail service are maintained throughout the year.



Southwestern Montana is famous for its trout streams. Within two or three hours from Haggin Ranch the guest may fish the Madison or Big Hole Rivers, Cliff lake, or many other equally noted streams and mountain lakes. Most visitors prefer to take short hiking-fishing trips right close to the ranch.
