Obit from the Des Moines Tribune March 1922:

The funeral of Rev. Datus D. Proper was held at harrisburg Church on Wed. afternoon March 8 with interment beside his wife in the Vale cemetery. Rev. Proper died quite suddenly at the home of Rev. J.S. Stump in New York City early Thursday morning March 2. Proper had an attack of influenza, but was not considered seriously ill. Members of the family heard him moving about his room about 4:30 O'clock Thursday morning. When he was called for breakfast there was no response and he was found lying on his back across the bed with his arms folded across his chest, it being evidence that he had passed away soon after they had heard him. Rev. Stump accompanied his remains here, arriving Thursday morning. Funeral services were held at one o'clock. Prayer by the Pastor Rev. J.S. Coppoc. An historial sketch was read by Rev. Stump. Rev G.P. Mitchell of Des Moines Baptist Missionary Secretary of Iowa gave a sketch of the work which the deceased had done in Iowa. Rev A.A. DeLarme, pstor of the First Baptist church of Omaha, Nev., of which Rev. Proper

During the religious agitation between the Protestants and Catholics in Scotland, many of the clans came to America. From Kirkudbright in Western Scotland, many McCutchens moved to Ulster, Donegal County, Ireland. In the annals of Ulster and County Down is found frequent mention of James, William, John and Robert McCutchen, who were ruling elders and vestrymen in the parishes of these parts. Later (1718-1728) the clan of McCutchen, together with that of the McKays, Campbells and others seeking religious freedom, moved to Western Virginia. There is no definite record of the date when they moved to America, but it is well known that all were established long before Virginia was made a state and that they fought in the Revolutionary War, because patents, deeds, marriage records and other old papers of that time bear their name. They settled in the western part of the "old Dominion", then the Beverly Manor grant from King George III, and later Augusta County, Virginia.

Five McCutchens, William, James, John, Samuel and Robert came to this western part of Virginia. Whether they were all brothers or some of them cousins, is unknown. Each of the five had a son named John, without initials, which made it hard to distinguish between them. The John whom we claim was a son of Robert. We are his direct descendants. Being Scotch Highlanders, they bought lands between the Blue Ridge and Allegheny Mountains from William Beverly, who was Colonial Governor for King George III. One old survey gave to Robert McCutchen "The land between the Brink or the Brew of Black Oak Hill to the top of the Watershed of North America."

William, James, and John McCutchen made their home at Beverly Manor, on the Big or Cow Pasture River. James died in 1750 and his sons, James, John and Patrick went to Washington County to live.

Samuel McCutchen settled in the Borden Grant.

Robert McCutchen, our ancestor, was born in 1705, and married Margaret \_\_\_\_\_ (maiden name unknown). He settled on Little Calf Pasture River. This farm is still owned by the McCutchens, who were the first private owners. In 1745 he built a mill near Graigsville, Augusta County, Virginia. His grandson, James McCutchen, was drowned in the mill race in 1861. In 1929 Robert McCutchen's great, great, great-granddaughter, Mary Lou McCutchen, is living on part of this old homestead with her father, Ira E. McCutchen, the son of John Benson McCutchen.
