



In reply to your letter of the 22nd October enclosing a copy of our letter of the 16th February, 1960, in which we quoted you for a best quality Westley Richards gun with detachable box locks; We note that you are not interested in a second-hand gun of this type so we are enclosing our leaflet on our new Connaught model gun which has fixed locks. The price of this gun is £250.0.0. in the two trigger model and £300.0.0. in the single trigger model. There will be an additional charge of £6.0.0. for a rubber recoil pad, and £15.15.0. for a raised solid rib. we can supply a nice light-weight leather case for £30.0.0. This would be a new, best quality leather case.

Our abbreviation D.B.H.E. stands for double barrelled hammerless ejector. We normally fully describe the type of lock work in our list which is either side lock, box lock, which is also known as the A & D which stands for Anson & Deeley, or detachable box locks which are our own patent type which can be removed from the gun without the use of any tools. The locks are removed by lifting the catch on the cover plate which exposes the locks and which can then be lifted out as a complete unit.


