It gives me pleasure to inform you that I have approved your appointment as:

BIDWELL FELLOW IN FORESTRY

in the University of California for the academic year 1930-31.

The income from the fellowship will be seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$750.00) payable as follows:

\$150.00 on September 15, 1930
75.00 each on October 15, November 15, December 15, 1930
150.00 on February 15, 1931
75.00 each on March 15, April 15, May 15, 1931

In order that you may receive these payments promptly, please call at the Office of the Comptroller of the University on the dates given above. Checks will not be mailed to Fellows from the Comptroller's Office.

Your appointment is conditioned upon your residence in the University, where you are to pursue study in Forestry. It is assumed that you will give your full time to study during the period of your incumbency of the fellowship and further that you will not resign this appointment except on conditions that are satisfactory to the President of the University.

Please indicate to the Dean of the Graduate Division, Room 113 California Hall, on the enclosed blank, on or before April 15th your acceptance or non-acceptance of this appointment.

Immediately after registering in the University in August 1930 you are requested to call on the Dean of the Graduate Division and discuss with him your plan of work for the year and other matters connected with your fellowship.
