BURGESS SPRINGS SHOULD NOT BE GRAZED BY ANY CLASS OF LIVESTOCK EXCEPT CATTLE. SHEEP SHOULD NOT BE **HEADED** TOO CLOSE TO PASTURES BECAUSE MOST EXPERIMENTAL CHECK PLOTS NOT SHEEP PROOF. MODERATE GRAZING BY CATTLE ACCEPTABLE. IF PASTURES NOT GRAZED TO DATE PREFERABLE WITHHOLD ALL GRAZING REMAINDER OF SEASON BECAUSE OF FORAGE MEASUREMENTS IN SEPTEMBER WITH PARKER FOR HIS SPECIAL CONDITION AND TREND PROJECT. PARKER'S SCHEDULE NOW BEING WORKED OUT.
