Reference is made to your memorandum of January 30.

Yes, we would again like to have 24 head of yearling heifers or steers graze in the Burgess Spring pastures, the distribution to be as follows:

| <u>No. of cattle</u> | <u>Pasture</u> | <u>Approximate season</u> |
|----------------------|--------------------------------|---------------------------|
| 8 | East meadow | June 1 - October 1 |
| 16 ^{1/2} | West meadow and east timber | June 1 - August 15 |
| | West timber | August 15 - October 1 |
| Total <u>24</u> | | |

1/2 These 16 head will have access to both the west meadow and east timber pastures during the period from June 1 to August 15. Requires opening the gates through the corrals. On August 15 these 16 head are to be moved into the west timber pasture for the remainder of the season.

It is doubtful that we will do any weighing this season, but adherence to this grazing schedule is important.

I will be attending an Extension Service meeting in Stan Brown's office in Susanville on March 6. Will drop into the forest office in the morning shortly after 8:00 A.M. and visit with you and Art if you are in.
