SUBJECT: Range Programs (Training in Range Management) our reference: 6140 10-29

I have checked with Mr. Norway to determine if it is feasible for him to plan on conducting a training session for personnel on the Deerledge and Beaverhead National Forests. As indicated in my memorandum of November 3, he has several important jobs to complete before June 30. One of these is the preparation of a guide for use by others to conduct training sessions in range management. In view of this heavy schedule, we feel it is unwise to divert Mr. Norway to other assignments for the remainder of this fiscal year.
