Subject: Time Period for Agency Review and Public Availability
of Environmental Statements (ES)

Offices should also make certain that sufficient copies of the ESs are available for agency and public review before submitting to Office of Environmental Project Review.

To: Heads of Bureaus and Offices

Subject: Time periods for agency review and public availability of environmental statements

1. This memorandum re-emphasizes and supplements:

- 516DM3.7B(3) - Federal agency review period
- 516DM3.7C(3) - State and local agency review period
- 516DM3.8B - Public availability prior to hearing period
- 516DM3.9C(2) & (3) - Public availability prior to administrative action period
- 516DM3.9F(3) - Processing of draft statements
- 516DM3.9F(5) - Processing of final statements
- PEP MEMO ES73-2 - Federal Register Notice of Availability
- PEP MEMO ES74-3 - Federal agency review period

2. The time periods for government agency and public review of draft environmental statements and for agency and public availability of draft and final statements prior to administrative action commence upon the latest of the three following events:

- Filing five (5) copies of the statement with the Council on Environmental Quality.
- Distributing sufficient copies of the statement to appropriate Federal agencies, and State and local agencies and/or clearinghouses.
- Publishing a notice of public availability of the statement in the Federal Register.

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3. The usual constraint in commencing these time periods is the lack of sufficient copies for agency distribution and for public availability. Because of this, the Office of Environmental Project Review will not file statements with CEQ or transmit availability notices to the Federal Register without firm evidence that sufficient copies of the statement are ready for agency distribution and will be publicly available by the date of publication of the Federal Register notice.
4. Bureaus and offices should promptly distribute copies for government agency review at the time of filing with CEQ with a goal of completion no later than the publication date in the Federal Register of the public availability notice. In addition, bureaus and offices should promptly initiate any other planned distribution of statements to other entities and persons by the publication date of the Federal Register notice and immediately respond to any subsequent public requests.
