I hope you will be able to come out to California this fall as you indicated to me in Montana last June. I would like to discuss several matters contained in the enclosed memorandum to the Station Director in 1977 with you.

You probably know I have continued to work at the Station as a volunteer since retiring. However, I have not been provided help or funds to carry out the projects described in the memo.

A great need is for someone to carry on with rest-rotation grazing explaining principles and application after I leave the scene.

One of the publications I plan to put out early is an up-to-date, modified version of Training Text-4 (2200), "Principles of Rest-Rotation Grazing and Multiple-Use Land Management." It will probably be titled simply, "Rest-Rotation Grazing."

Please let me know as soon as possible if you can make it. I have two more field trips to schedule between now and October 15, one to the Lassen and one to Montana, vicinity of Butte and Dillon.

Dear Chase:

I received the base map and travel route map you sent me and have made good use of them. I need the additional information I requested before I can go much further in sizing up the situation on the ranch and crystalizing possibilities for rest-rotation grazing. If you can, please get the information to me by the first of the year.

No question about getting desired results with rest-rotation grazing. The range will be improved and maintained. Forage will be increased and more efficiently used. Increased livestock production can be anticipated. But it will require diligent planning to figure out how to apply the system best under the conditions that prevail on the ranch.

I want to see you ease into rest-rotation grazing management by trying it on a portion of the ranch with one group of cattle so you can see first hand what may be expected. Information from such a pilot effort would provide invaluable information for planning management on the rest of the ranch and on any additional properties leased or acquired.

It is not too early to start telling agency people, ranchers and others you'd like to have attend, about the March 1982 rest-rotation grazing management session. The success of a rest-rotation grazing program on the ranch depends considerably on their interest and cooperation.

Please give my regards to your mom, Whit.?, Scott and Neil. In the rush to the airport I failed to say good-bye to Sharon? the cook. Please explain to her.
