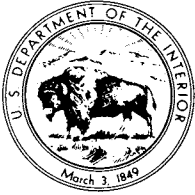


Dear Diane,
