Just thought you would want to know that all was not lost when the Lassen took out some of the exclosures in Harvey Valley.


In June I was in Harvey and took the time to look for transects 94 & 94A in exclosure #3. Your reinforcing rod stakes (the control points) were in place. While the head and tail stakes are gone, the transects can be successfully reestablished.

While the fence has been taken down on exclosure #4 (across the fence from exclosure #3), the transects are still in place.

Also, I got to the rebuilt exclosure below Burgess Springs and found the control points, the 6' photo plot, at the start of one transect. With work it should be possible to reestablish that transect, but the number of the transect was not available.

I hope this finds you well and that you have completed your book.
