Information ^{related to} my re search on rest-rotation grazing will not be available to any one ~~before~~ ^{until after} my ~~the~~ book is published.

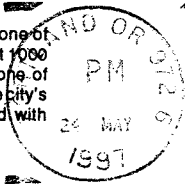
