Grazing has been

decreased and dried  
up altogether forcing  
cattle to graze on  
areas where water  
was still available

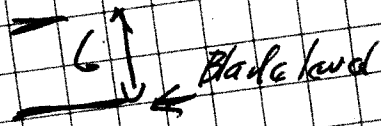

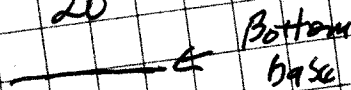
