

SEED AND PLANT COLLECTION
Burgess Spring Experimental Range, 1937

In 1936 a plant collection was started by L. R. Short, at which time 158 specimens of 144 species were collected at the Burgess Spring Experimental Range and vicinity. Such a collection is valuable for identification work in the field and for demonstration purposes. In 1937, 26 new species were added. Temporary identifications have been received from Washington for the Short collection.

Seed of 41 species was collected this year in small quantities and will be put in small glass vials to aid in identification.

Seed of 8 species was collected in larger quantities and will be used in greenhouse and nursery studies.
