possible technique: to show Keith's and Frew's reactions, use phrases without quote marks and simply end the line with: , thought Keith. (or, Keith was thinking.)
example:

The military life was eating molecules out him, thought Keith.

Roddy Doyle's Dublin soul novel, The Commitments:

--example for Left-Handed Rainbow in use of dialogue.

--Doyle doesn't use quotation marks, simply dashes before each piece of dialogue; but they vary in length, to indicate the span of pause before the person speaks.
