
On November 16th, the District Judge signed a Decree of Distribution in the Charles C. Doig Estate which distributes all of the Estate property to Ivan Doig and places sole ownership of the jointly-owned property in your name. A certified copy of this Decree is being recorded in the Meagher County real estate records which has the same effect as a deed, placing title to the real property in Ivan's name.

I am enclosing for your records copies of the Order Determining Inheritance Tax and the Decree of Distribution so you will have a complete file of this probate matter. The only thing that remains to be done is to transfer the title to the Dodge car, and in this regard, there is enclosed an Application for a Certificate of Title which Ivan should sign in the place indicated and have notarized. You may then take this Application, together with a certified copy of the Decree of Distribution and the Certificate of Title to the vehicle, to the Meagher County Treasurer's office where they will forward all the necessary papers to the State Registrar for transfer.

Also enclosed is a Receipt to be signed by Ivan and a Petition for Discharge which is to be signed by you; when these are signed, please return them to my office so that they can be filed in the Court file and I can have the Judge sign an order discharging you from any further duties or obligation to the Estate. When the Discharge is entered, this matter will be completely settled.

Hope everything has progressed to your satisfaction.

Dear Ivan: Am in the middle of trials, so will answer this way, please excuse.

I distinctly remember our conversation and looked for a note in my files but couldn't find any. A check of the minimum fee schedules shows that the State Bar Association minimum fee for any estate probate proceeding is \$350, and the District Association minimum fee "Absolute minimum for all Probate matters: \$200.00", although confusing to me too, the latter would include termination of joint tenancies which is less complicated than estate proceedings, while the former would apply to estates. This is just by way of explanation; if I said \$200 it will be that and I am sure your recollection is better than mine. Regards, *Ivan*

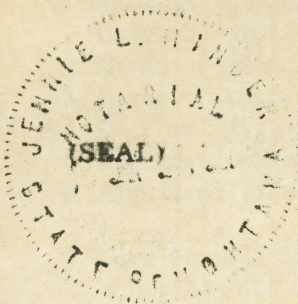
