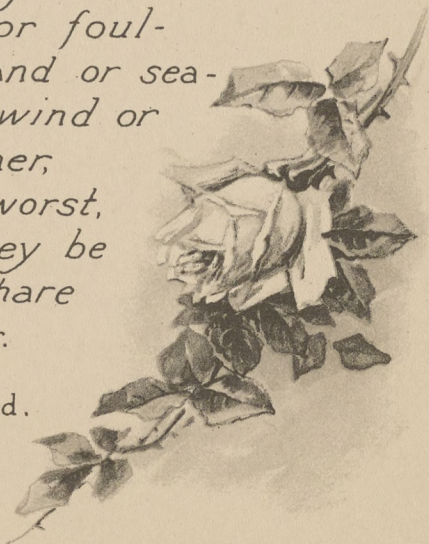
*As when from

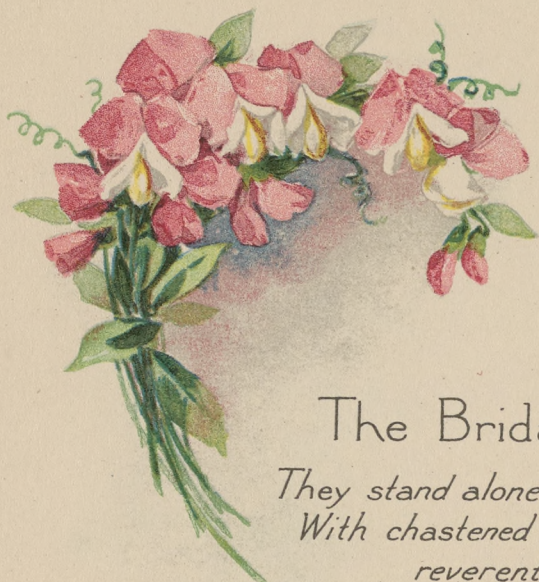


From this hour

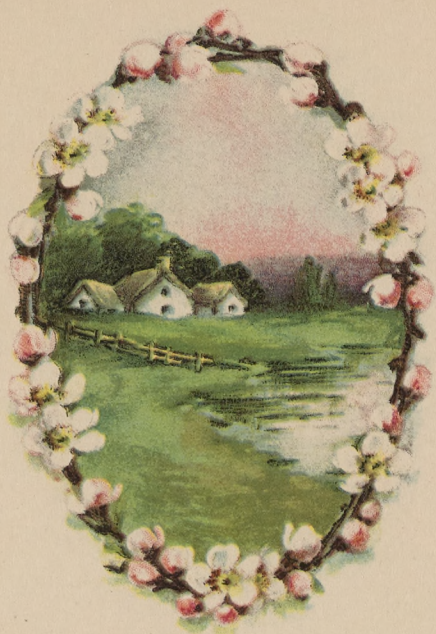
