Jack Rabbit Drive

Conducted annually under supervision of Spokane Police Department. In former years the jacks were distributed among the Spokane poor, in later years this is not done because of danger through infected or diseased rabbits, and they are destroyed or used as hog feed.

The practice is to invite citizens who desire to participate. A fee of \$2 is charged which is for bus transportation. Coffee is furnished by the police, but each individual brings his own lunch. (Information obtained from George Sexsmith, Detective, Spokane Police Dept.)
