SCRIPTURE FRUIT CAKE

- 1 cup butter (Judges, 5:25)
- 2 cups sugar (Jer. 6:20)
- 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ cups flour (I Kings, 4:22)
- 2 cups raisins (I Sam. 30:12)
- 2 cups figs (I Sam. 30:12)
- 1 cup water (Gen. 24:17)
- 1 cup almonds (Gen. 43:11)
- 6 eggs (Isa. 10:14)
- 1 tablespoon honey (Exed. 16:31)
- 1 pinch salt (Lev. 2:13)
- Spice to taste (I Kings, 10:10)
- 2 tablespoons baking powder (I Cor. 5:6)
