The Fossil Collection in the Foyer of the Fort Peck Theatre, Fort Peck, Montana, site of construction of the world's largest earth-fill dam. On the pedestal to the left is the hind foot of a giant duck-bill dinosaur. The huge thigh bone on the right pedestal indicates an animal more than 12 feet high.

This collection contains more than 6000 specimens, most of which are over 50,000,000 years old. All of these specimens were collected by civilian engineers on the project and by farmers in the Fort Peck area during leisure moments.
