Since the inception of the Administrative Report series in 1932, a large amount of valuable information has been accumulated about the fish and fisheries of California. This series has never been adequately indexed, although prior to this report, biennial and periodic listings were issued.

This index is designed to increase the utility of these reports by providing an author-title index covering the complete series since its inception. The index includes all Administrative Reports through 1953 and all of the reports by members of the former Bureau of Fish Conservation. Also included are the first ten reports of 1954.

Although the index is compiled by author and alphabetically by title, the year and number of the report are listed in the left-hand margin under the author's name. The first two numbers indicate the year, while the numbers to the right of the dash show the number of the report in the given year. The numbers are assigned in accordance with the Administrative Report list of January 1, 1955.

A subject index is also being formulated for this series, and it should be ready for compilation in the near future.
