around ankles, wrists, neck.

I get rid of it - lay flat. Looked up saw

"There you are. Now I'll get you. About  
7 or 8 branches, got big stick, pounded

chipmunk. Hana 0 pō soh'

Eli's 1st shot a black bird - a  $\frac{2}{3}$  (5) flint lock -  
9 yrs. old.  
12 " " packed gun most of time - a  
double barrel flint lock - a smooth bore  
His father shot a " " " "  
32 balls 6 lb.

English bullet only 30 - harder.  
1st real rifle was a Hawkes -  
Took a heavy carbine - 66 model - later  
Winchester  
Remington - a repeater. Loaded with  
thumb screw - turned around - exposed  
magazine - spring pulled up - threw  
shells in backward. - held 6 shells.

His gun was loaded from side - patented  
before 73 Winchester came out.  
Bought one of these from Joe Butsch - for  
wolf skins (was buying boxes of walrus  
trappers) Got it at dusk. At daylight  
Indians around - Sweet Grass Hills -  
Piegan. Eli 2 horses. Another for work -  
noticed pole with those made of sticks -  
a war lodge - Father had field glasses  
saw 1/2 doz. heads looking over rocks.  
Traders in - gave them whiskey.

White people & half breeds - + Ted 2/3 (4)  
Towers.

Piegans stole woman, (71-2) Brochy  
ran off with her - Tom Hardwick's wife. He  
got down on the woman. Tom called her  
stand off - got her there.

Van Hale 1 of 1st rangus in Yellowstone  
country - Park. In north until 1876.

Piegans were drunk. Elis made hollowed  
in Assiniboin.

Elis father started me to stop the Piegans  
then in camp drunk - will shoot them. Only  
1 who wouldn't drink, he a fool, left handed.

Father said Who are you

Said: Pitame

Father: Maybe Blood

Said: no answer.

Father: Go down evening

Isiah went up -

Hardwick climbed hill - shot at them -  
didn't hit.

Elis into Boston's house

Put gun in shack - at home.

Boston threw dish water out, grabbed for

old Spencer rifle.

Elis grabbed gun - Father sent him to  
talk with Piegans.

Another party altogether, 50 ~ 60 <sup>2/3</sup> (7)  
one Assin. Gros. Yankton - That they  
were the Piegans back.

Father: glad = are all one

Ind: 2, Chipewyan,

Father: Try to escape. Whites will shoot  
anything.

Eli. shot - into bunch

Ind. ran into country:

2 tried to escape - jumped off bank.  
I knocked 1 down, shot other as he climbed  
up bank.

Butch asked for Eli's gun - wanted some fun.  
Ran the Ind. into mts. Killed 12.

as warriors in Eli's camp - white & mixed.  
Eli only 14 yrs. old.

Eli to Piegans in 1868 - 11 yrs. old.  
Killed an antelope same year.

Antelope around Swiss town, bet. Mussel shell &  
Missouri.

Winter good in dome - on flats like herd of  
sheep.

Wolves - One carcass - buffalo - and dead wolves  
around it next morning.

Came into camp - caught horses. Scare away  
on horse's back.

Killed game when they needed it. 2/3 (8)  
Ind. had a hunt. Some had better hands  
could get more. Some got cold hands  
easily, couldn't kill more than 1 or 2.  
Eli got 18 fat cows in 1 run. Used repeating  
rifle.

Held bullet in mouth. Measured powder in  
hands, made 1/2 of hand. Dropped bullet after  
powder.

Some preferred bow + arrow. Put 3 arrows at  
a time. Eli never when in the run used arrows  
used arrow stem of service berry bush for small  
game - no point.

Bows all same length. Others much longer  
than Eli made.

Short wouldn't catch, fashion, could pull it  
easily - didn't shoot so far as long ones.  
Could hit buff cow in back & split back  
bone - with arrow. Also split shoulder bone  
in hard part.

Some buff bull coming along. One horse took  
run 15 ft. away, hit on top of rump -  
~~bullet~~ <sup>arrow</sup> came out collar. (Better than rifle).  
Great strength. That they had missed it.  
Bull fell. arrow thru lung. shot into dirt.

Green wood; oak, elm, ash (Manitoba <sup>2/3</sup> (9)  
7th sapling 2 2nd growth. White flat  
dry it, in fire place - half of winter. When  
dry enough burned it, tapered gradually.  
Flattened. No knots.

Could kill buff. in head with muzzle load  
but not with 73 Winchester 44. Shot behind  
shoulder.
