



It even sent me back to my book shelves to review the Jock Scott book, Leisenring and Hidy, Atherton and Skues. Since I do read most of the fly-fishing magazines, I've been aware of your work with the soft-hackles for quite awhile. I resisted purchasing the book, just as I've resisted jumping on many bandwagons, in an interest in keeping my fishing relatively simple. (I'm sure you've heard of the KISS philosophy - Keep It Simple, Stupid.) I should have bought your book in '75 and forgotten about a lot of the other things I've tried in the meantime. It's obvious that you too share the KISS attitude. Wonderful. Some of the wooly-buggers, Adams, GR Hare's Ear, muddlers and a few others will probably remain in my vest, but your Soft-Hackles will get a heavy work out. Which gets us to the reason for this letter - partridge hackle. I though my stock of tying materials would let me tie just about anything around. Wrong. The grouse hackle I had on hand just doesn't look like the photos in your fine book. The packet I ordered from one of the few supply houses that handle partridge, provided only pretty large feathers. The note you sent with your book says you have partridge skins with small feathers - those for sizes to 16 and 18. Please send me one. Twenty bucks is enclosed. What does one do for snipe, jackdaw, dotterel and starling on the eve of the 21st century? Have you tried substituting ruffed grouse and woodcock hackle for partridge? More importantly, do the trout like it? My little 20 ga. double usually provides a few each fall. I also wondered about painting small hooks in approprite colors but quickly decided that thread bodies would be more efficient, wound on faster than paint with no drying time. (Thanks anyway, A.H.E.Wood.) Have you had any reports on the use of soft-hackles in Alaska? I hope to exercise some Dolly Vardens and grayling there in August while visiting my son. If there are caddisses there, soft-hackles must be effective. Both species will be much more fun on a 5 weight rod than salmon on an 8 weight. (I'll take both, but have held salmon in low esteem since their introduction in Michigan. Maybe I'm just a bitter old fuddy-duddy, but I still believe they've done considerable damage to the habitat needed by my little pets, the speckled beauties. More than enough. I've taken too much of your time already. Thanks very much for writing "The Soft-Hackled Fly" and PLEASE dispatch me one of your lovely partridge skins. Gray would be nice if you have it, but the expert that wrote the book says brown is OK too. That's good enough for me. Thanks very much, Bill Breed







Dear Fly Fishing Friend:

Well, I'm writing you to tell you about my new book, SPINNERS, the first book dedicated solely to adult mayflies. I spent three years collecting, studying and identifying spinners (with the help of an entomologist from Montana State University). The book records dates of appearance, molting and mating habits and colors, shapes and sizes of nearly 40 species. There are more than 30 new spinner patterns which are quick and easy to tie from readily available materials. A new winging method (the most difficult part of tying a spinner as you know) is described using only hackle fibers which are divided, flattened and pulled with thumbs and forefingers. (No difficult figure 8's.)

New patterns, like Syl's Gold Plated spinner and Syl's Gold Tail spinner are highly productive during a spinner fall and are also very effective during the hatch of duns. There are also dun/spinners with the body of spinners and wings of duns to be fished anytime, and doubles, two small flies tied on larger hooks for better visibility and better hooking.

The book is 6 x 9, with 157 pages of black and white text and with a 16 page color section featuring some rare macro photos of spinners including one just molting out of its dun skin.

Just a note to say hello and to say I met you years ago at State College, Pa. You were giving a course on tying wet flies. Since that time I have become intrigued with that type of fly fishing. As a matter of fact I have all your books and one of Dave Hughes. They are most interesting.

I have been using Mustad hooks in sizes 10 to 18 – 3906. I have not been using 3906-B. Do you use any fine wire hooks in your wet fly fishing?

It seems that good quality hen hackle is difficult to obtain- especially the white brown brown edge type. Where could I obtain good quality hackle?On the subject of the classic winged bugs it seems that you stress the hackled type over the winged type.

Do you fold your hackle.? Frankly im having one hell of a time trying to learnhow to fold hackle for wets. Also Sly do U have any formula for leaders ? I fish mostly in West. Pa.

FinallyI am following this method of applying hackle to the hook. I might add also that I am using Pearsall's thread all the time and wondering if I should usetheir floss at times- Most of the patternseem to stress their thread.

Hope U are not bored with there dumb questions. It seems that your books stimulated me to go into the wct s full speed. Thanks again for your patience- Best wishes for a blessed Christmas and New Year


